Ministry of Transportation Projects



OnRoute BC

- Begin roll out early 2024
- Custom permitting system
 - routing, clearances, corridor weight limits, project restrictions
- Agile rollout - term size -> weight -> single trips

Truck Parking Strategy (Lower mainland)

- Nordel
 - 40 heavy truck stalls
 - Bathrooms and heated showers
 - Sani-dump
- Hwy 91 pullout
 - Short term parking stalls
- North Surrey Truck Parking (Feb.2024)
 - 106 commercial stalls (variety of lengths and plug-ins)
 - bathrooms and heated showers
 - RV facilities

Rest Area Management Plan

- Funding secured for \$100M over 9 yrs. New and improvement to current facilities
- Key rest areas identified by industry:
 - Hwy 1 Kamloops
 - Hwy 1 Revelstoke
 - Hwy 5 Merritt
- Ongoing engagement to address amenity needs, to optimize space, and accommodate user volumes
