New West Partnership

- Permit available for Digital/LED signs for Escort Vehicles
- Permit coming for Extended Length Saddle Mounts
- New version of Alberta's Escort Vehicle Operator's Handbook soon to be available on the web for broad review



General

- **High Load Corridor Study is now complete. Department is currently working on an Investment Strategy**
- **This winter, Winter Weights will come into effect when we see 0.75 metre of frost as opposed to previous 1.0 metre**
- **Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation was updated in June 2018. Unfortunately, only minor administrative amendments were incorporated; a permit is still required to operate MOU amendments**

TRAVIS

- **New TRAVIS Permitting/Routing system expected to be in place for January 2020.**
- **RFP should be out to the vendors mid December**
